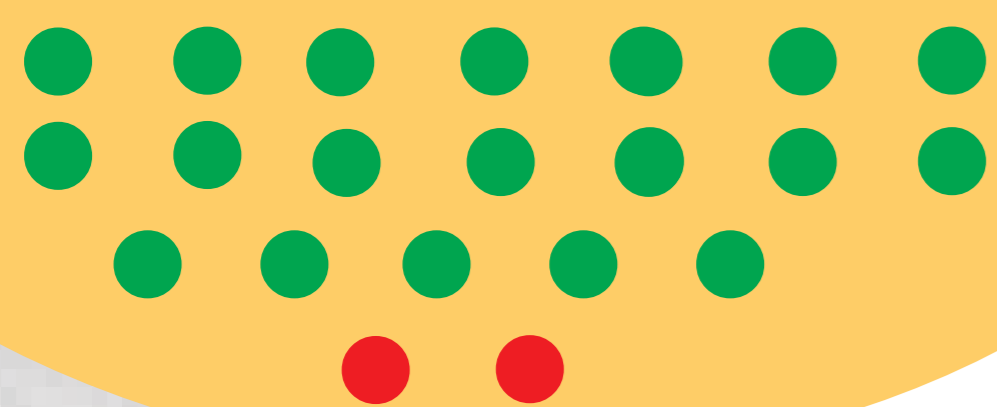

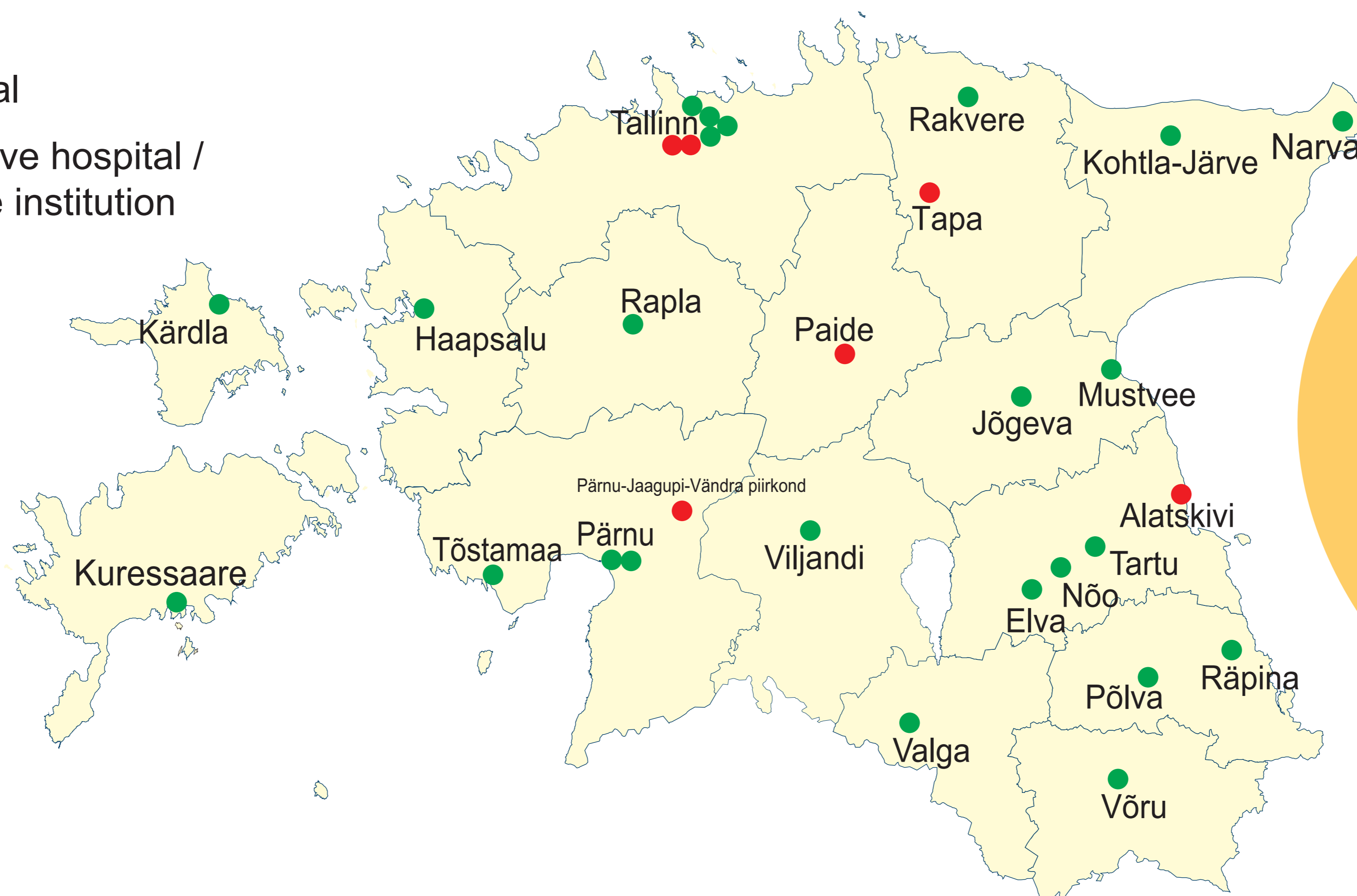
ESTONIAN HPH NETWORK

Estonian HPH Network was established in 2000.
The network comprises 24 hospitals (49% of the common hospitals' data) and 76% of the overall opened treatment beds.
It has 6 collaborative institutions/ the potential joiners (hospitals, health care centres, medical schools).

Finnish International Health Care Staff Exchange Programm



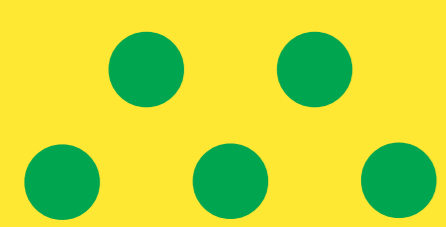
